1. Welcome:

The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting especially new member Harry Newman

2. Minutes of the Last Meeting:

The minutes were agreed as being correct.

3. New Appointment System

There was much discussion on the new system which took most of the meeting. Reaction is very mixed from patients. Many of the PPG had not had to use the system themselves but had heard reports from other patients who both liked and disliked it.

Figures show that on one day 269 patients had been dealt with by doctors on the two sites. This figure could not have been achieved using the old system and many needing attention would have to try the following day. With the new consultation system some had been saved an unnecessary journey either because the matter could be dealt with as would a normal 'telephone consultation' would have been dealt with or because the patient needed to have blood test before they could see the doctor. They could then book an appointment with the phlebotomist in the usual manner.

As at the outset of the trial, patients who cannot speak English or who are deaf or for those who, a telephone consultation may not be appropriate arrangements could be arranged. They are encouraged to find someone on their behalf. The LIPS service is useful where a translator is required. Receptionist can help book this service. Request for home visits are still accepted where appropriate. The trial continues and the Practice have taken notes of the objections made and are looking at ways to improve the system.
